



REGULATIONS OF "LES EGLANTIERS" TENNIS CLUB 2017

Art. 1: How to become a member for the summer season (15th April - 14th September)

- Enrolment via website www.leseglantiers.be.
- In order to benefit from the "Large Family" price list, provide a proof of household composition.
- In order to benefit from the price list for residents in Woluwe-Saint-Pierre and Wezembeek, provide a copy of an identity card (printing via an ID reader) or a certificate of residence (Town Hall).
- Documents can be sent by e-mail to tc.leseglantiers@scarlet.be or handed in at the "Club House".
- A photo (jpeg, gif or png format) is required.
- Pay the membership fee to account BE 30 3100 8220 0011
(communication : Name and Surname of member to be enrolled)
- Enrolment also by appointment at the tennis secretariat (Planning department) available during working hours by phone: 02.773.18.47.
- Through enrolment, the participant submits to these regulations that he/she is supposed to perfectly be aware of.

Art. 2: Bookings

- a) Bookings for members are made via the Internet on www.ballejaune.com.
- b) Members can book 7 working days in advance.
- c) **Members cannot book two consecutive hours, but if court availability allows it, they may play an additional period.**
- d) Members can book two hours of match/play per week. Once the first hour is finished, a second hour can be booked. This allows playing every day.
- e) Every match that is interrupted for reasons beyond players' control (for instance, bad weather) will be considered as finished at the end of the hour during which it has been interrupted.
- f) Every booked court, not occupied after the first 10 minutes, will be made available again.
- g) Management organises tournaments and books, for this purpose, the necessary courts for the smooth running of the competition. The greatest attention will always be paid to the availability of spaces available to members and according to specific possibilities.
- h) In case of bad weather or impracticability of outdoor courts, if several members of a same family are already occupying various courts, they should come together in a single playing area.



Art. 3: Occupation of courts

- Regardless of the booking time, a player cannot enter the court without first going to the "Club House" in order to be informed of a possible change in the allocation of the court.
- Players should occupy the court mentioned in the "ballejaune" planning.
- The outdoor courts are accessible from 8.00 a.m., unless informed otherwise by the maintenance worker. The indoor courts are accessible from 8.00 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- The summer season starts on 15th April and ends on 14th September. However, outdoor courts will remain available beyond this term, as long as the weather permits.

Art. 4: Invitations

- a) During the season, each member has one invitation.
- b) The invitation right (€ 5 per hour) will be payable before the match.
- c) The invitation right of any partner not registered at the reception will be invoiced to the member, plus a penalty of € 20.

Art. 5: Dress Code

1. In the tennis hall, the use of regulatory and clean tennis shoes is required. It is forbidden to play in the tennis hall with dirty shoes.
2. On clay courts, the use of flat-soled tennis shoes is mandatory.
3. The conformity of shoes described above guarantees the quality and durability of playing courts; any violation will be immediately excluded.
4. Tennis clothes are required on the courts.
5. No player can practice without a T-shirt.

Art. 6: Control

- All players are likely to be controlled at any time of the day or evening. These checking procedures protect the members from fraudulent people; so they should take place with courtesy.
- The management reserves the right to exclude any person whose behaviour, attitude or language could harm the reputation of or in the interest of the Églantiers or its members.



Art. 7: Tennis Lessons

1. Teachers from the ATA tennis school, approved by the club, are at the disposal of the members and are the only ones certified to give the lessons.
2. The management reserves the right to designate as volunteer coach of the club, any competent person, who is a club member.

Art. 8: Various

- a) The management declines all responsibility for clothes or items damaged, stolen or lost inside the property. In the entrance hall, small lockers are made available to the clients for free (ask for a key, against a deposit of € 5 paid at the desk).
- b) The management declines all responsibility in case of accidents.
ONLY THE MEMBERSHIP CARD OF THE ASSOCIATION FRANCOPHONE DE TENNIS (AFT) COVERS YOU IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT ON THE COURT.
- c) It is forbidden to enter the courts outside opening hours.
- d) Access to the courts is restricted to players registered via ballejaune.
Other people and children who are not players are not allowed to be there.
- e) It is strictly forbidden to smoke inside the playing areas and inside the Club House.
- f) It is strictly forbidden to bring animals into the changing rooms and into the playing areas.
- g) Whoever damages, intentionally or unintentionally, the facilities or the equipment is responsible for the damage caused.
- h) A notice board in the "Club House" will inform members about club activities.
Information will also be posted on "Les Églantiers Tennis Club" Facebook page, via ballejaune or e-mail.
- i) In case of bad weather, the courts in the tennis hall may be used according to the availability at that moment.

MANAGEMENT, CERTIFIED STAFF, TEACHERS FROM THE TENNIS SCHOOL AND STAFF OF THE CLUB HOUSE ARE RECOMMENDED TO APPLY THESE REGULATIONS IMPARTIALLY.

ANYONE WHO DOESN'T COMPLY WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS, IN A PURPOSE OF GENERAL INTEREST, MAY BE EXPELLED FROM THE PREMISES AND SEE HIS/HER ENROLMENT AT THE CLUB CANCELLED WITHOUT ANY REIMBURSEMENT OR COMPENSATION.

THE MANAGEMENT IS RESPONSIBLE OF SOLVING ALL CASES NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THIS REGULATION.
